

Test Results...

You can expect to receive the results of your lab tests and x-rays within 2 weeks unless you have a follow-up appointment. If a result requires immediate attention, you will be notified by phone. If you have NOT received any results after two weeks please call our office. **DO NOT** assume a lab result is "normal" or "negative" merely because you haven't heard from us. Please call the office to let us know you haven't received your results.

Medical Records and Confidentiality...

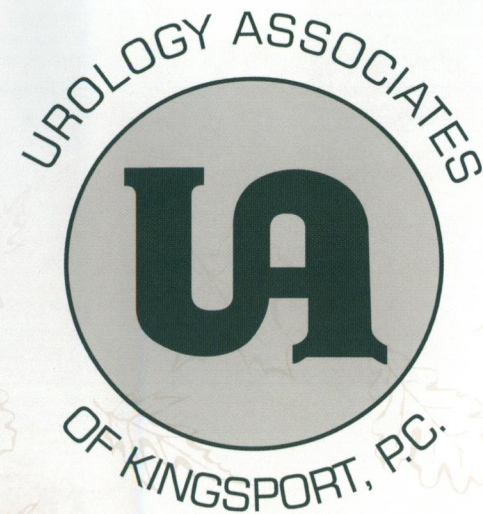
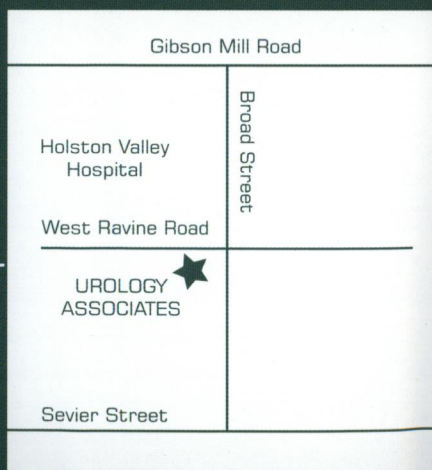
Your medical records are confidential. Per guidelines/regulations, we will require a written authorization to release any or all of your records.

After Hours and Emergencies...

If you are experiencing a problem after hours, please call 423-246-6251 to talk with our answering service which may contact the physician on call. If you feel you have an emergency please go to your nearest emergency room or call 911.

Here's a reminder of what you need to bring to your appointment...

1. Your insurance card(s).
2. Photo ID.
3. Copayment/payment for your visit. Your insurance may require us to collect a copayment at the time of your visit. You may be rescheduled if payment cannot be paid at the time of your appointment.
4. List of current prescription and any over-the-counter medications you are currently taking. Please include the strength/dosage and frequency.
5. Any recent imaging studies (x-rays, CTs, ultrasounds, scans, etc). A CD, DVD format is preferred along with the physician's final report. Failure to bring these studies may result in a delay in your visit.
6. Any recent laboratory or pathology results (blood/urine/biopsied tissue).
7. Completed Registration and History/Physical forms if you have not returned these forms prior to your appointment date. Completing forms and returning them to our office before your appointment will save time on the day of your visit.

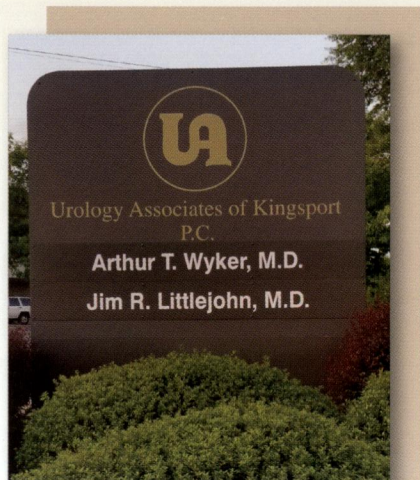

Appointments/ Office Hours...

Urology Associates is open 7:30 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. Monday through Thursday. We are closed for lunch from 12:00 p.m. – 12:30 p.m. If you have not completed your new patient packet prior to your first appointment please arrive 1 hour before your scheduled appointment to complete the paperwork. If you have completed your paperwork please arrive 30 minutes before your scheduled time. To cancel or reschedule your appointment please give 48 hours notice. You may receive a \$20.00 charge for failure to keep an office appointment. Scheduled procedures that are missed may incur a \$50.00 charge. We appreciate your assistance.

Prescription Refills...

Please be aware that prescription refills will take 48-72 hours to call in after the request has been made. Please be proactive in determining when you need to request a refill so that you do not run out of needed medication.

Referrals...

As a specialty office we see new patients by doctor referral. Many insurance plans also require your primary care physician to make the referral to the specialist. To avoid delays, please call our office prior to your appointment to confirm we have the referral or bring any required referral for treatment at the time of your visit. If you do not have a referral your visit may be rescheduled or you may be financially responsible.

Insurance, Insurance Cards, and Self Pay...

Our office participates and files a variety of insurance plans. Please confirm with your insurance plan that we are in their participating network prior to your appointment. We cannot bill your insurance company without the proper information. Please make sure all insurance information is up-to-date at each appointment, including your address and phone numbers. We will not be responsible for any liability insurance (disability, FMLA, cancer policies, etc.). Payment for services on any liability claims is due and payable at the time of service. Patients having no health insurance are required to pay at the time of service unless other arrangements are made prior to your visit. If you are unable to pay in full for necessary medical care at the time of service our patient account representative will attempt to assist you with a solution.

Copayments and Deductibles...

All co-payments and deductibles are due at the time of check-in. Co-payments and deductibles for surgery will need to be paid at the time of your pre-operative appointment. If your insurance plan changes between the time you see the physician for the preoperative visit and the procedure please notify our office so that necessary changes can be made prior to your surgery. You will be responsible if this is not done. If you have a high deductible insurance plan you may use a credit card for the entire balance that is due.
